WARNING

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE

Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR INJURY:

USING THE VACUUM CLEANER

•**DO NOT** use the vacuum cleaner outdoors. For household use only. Store indoors.

•DO NOT vacuum up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws or coins that could damage the vacuum cleaner.

•**DO NOT** vacuum liquids, use on wet surfaces or immerse in water as this could cause damage to the vacuum cleaner.

•**DO NOT** vacuum anything flammable, burning or smoking such as cigarette ends, matchsticks or ashes.

•**DO NOT** use the vacuum cleaner to clean your pets or any animal.

• Keep the vacuum cleaner moving over the carpet surface at all times to avoid damaging the carpet fibres.

• Keep the vacuum cleaner and accessories away from hot surfaces like hobs, cookers or microwave ovens.

• Always unplug the vacuum cleaner immediately if it malfunctions.

•**DO NOT** use this vacuum cleaner if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, submerged in water or is not working as it should.

•**DO NOT** use the vacuum cleaner in an enclosed space filled with explosive, toxic or flammable vapours.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

PLUG AND CORD

•**DO NOT** use with a damaged cord or plug.

•**DO NOT** pick up or pull the vacuum cleaner by the cord.

•Take care that the cord is not kinked, pinched, pulled around sharp corners or run over.

•Ensure the cord does not come into contact with heat sources or become a trip hazard.

•When unplugging the vacuum cleaner from the wall socket, pull by the plug, not the cord, holding the socket with your other hand.

AIRFLOW, FILTERS AND ATTACHMENTS

•**DO NOT** use without filters and bag in place.

• Always turn off and unplug the vacuum cleaner before changing filters or attachments.

• If when using, suction appears to be reduced, turn off and unplug the vacuum cleaner and clean all of the filters.

•**DO NOT** use if the airflow is restricted. If the air paths or the floor nozzle become

blocked, turn off and unplug the vacuum cleaner. Clear all obstructions before powering on again.

• Use genuine Dirt Devil filters and attachments only. Using non-genuine accessories may cause damage to the vacuum cleaner.

•When cleaning filters, ensure that they are completely dry and undamaged before replacing them back into the vacuum cleaner.

PERSONAL SAFETY

 This machine is not intended to be used or cleaned by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience or knowledge, unless they have been given instructions concerning the machine by a person legally responsible for their safety. 

ASSEMBLING YOUR VACUUM CLEANER

ASSEMBLING YOUR VACUUM CLEANER

Before assembling or disassembling attachments, ensure the cylinder vacuum cleaner is not plugged into the mains supply and is switched off.


1. Attach the hose to the main body of the vacuum cleaner by sliding the hose connection into the hose socket until you hear a click. To release the hose, press the hose release button and pull it outwards.

2. Put the metal telescopic tube on the other end of the hose.

3. Adjust the metal telescopic tube to the desired height by pressing the tube height regulator downwards and by pulling the lower part to the desired height. When storing the vacuum cleaner adjust the metal telescopic tube to the lowest possible position.

4. Place the desired accessory on the metal telescopic tube.

The floor tool can be used on either hard floors or carpets. For hard floors e.g. wood or tiles press the floor tool regulator to lower the brushes. For carpets, press the floor tool regulator to raise the brushes.



USING YOUR VACUUM CLEANER

USING YOUR VACUUM CLEANER

CAUTION

Do not use the vacuum cleaner without placing the bag and filter in the correct position!

Assemble the vacuum cleaner (see "Assembling your vacuum cleaner").

1. Pull the cord to the desired length while holding the appliance body and plug it into the socket.

CAUTION: The yellow mark on the power cord indicates it is extended almost all the way. When you see the red mark do not pull the cord any further.


2. Press the power button to start the vacuum cleaner.

3. When you have finished cleaning, press the power button again.

4. Disconnect the appliance from the wall socket.

5. To wind the cord, push the cord rewind button with one hand and guide the cord with the other hand to make sure that it does not get damaged or tangled as it wraps.

6. Disconnect the floor tool from the metal telescopic tube and disconnect the other end of the tube from the hose. Adjust the metal telescopic tube to the lowest possible position. The vacuum cleaner may be stored in a vertical or horizontal position. The hose can remain attached to the vacuum cleaner, but please be careful not to bend it too much during storage.



CHANGING THE DUST BAG


CAUTION

Do not use the vacuum cleaner without placing the dust bag and filter in the correct position! Before replacing the dust bag, remove the power cord plug from the wall socket. Always use the vacuum cleaner with a dust bag fitted.

- **1.** After disconnecting the hose, open the front cover by lifting it upwards.
- 2. Release the dust bag lock and remove the synthetic bag from the guides, if filled with dust.
- 3. Insert a new dust bag by sliding it into the guides.

4. Close the cover by pressing it down until it clicks. If you forget to insert a dust bag or it is fitted incorrectly, the cover cannot be closed completely - fix the position of a dust bag and close the cover.

If the dust bag full indicator goes on, check the floor tool, metal telescopic tube or hose for blockages stopping the airflow. After removing the items, if present, restart the vacuum cleaner. If the dust bag full indicator is still red, replace the dust bag with a new one.



CLEANING THE HEPA PRE-MOTOR FILTER

CAUTION

Do not use the vacuum cleaner without placing the bag and filter in the correct position!

Before cleaning the filter, remove the power cord plug from the wall socket. The filter should be cleaned when it is visibly dirty.


- 1. Remove the dust bag.
- 2. Remove the filter by sliding it up from the guides.

3. Clean the filter by washing it in lukewarm water with no detergent. (If the filter is damaged, replace it with a new one).

- 4. Leave the filter to air dry for at least 24 hours.
- 5. Replace the filter only when completely dry by placing it in the guides.

Always use the vacuum cleaner with a filter in place. Failure to install the filter may result in motor damage. Make sure it is correctly inserted before using the vacuum cleaner again.

It is recommended that you only use original Dirt Devil filters for your vacuum cleaner.



CLEANING THE HEPA POST-MOTOR FILTER


CAUTION

Do not use the vacuum cleaner without the filter in the correct position!

Before cleaning the filter, remove the power cord plug from the wall socket.

- 1. Open the air exhaust cover.
- 2. Clean the filter when it is clearly dirty.
- **3.** Remove the filter, shake off any dirt and then brush it with a soft bristle brush.
- 4. Rinse the filter in lukewarm water, without any detergent. Do not direct strong jets of water onto the filter.
- 5. Leave the filter to air dry for at least 24 hours.
- 6. Replace the filter only when completely dry. Close the air exhaust cover.
- In case of heavy soiling or lasting damage, replace the filter with a new one.

Depending on the intensity of use, it is recommended that you clean the filter once a month and replace it with a new one after ten cleaning cycles. Always use the vacuum cleaner with a filter in place.




CLEANING THE OUTER BODY

CAUTION

Always turn off and unplug the vacuum cleaner for cleaning or maintenance. Do not use strong or abrasive products for cleaning the outer surface of the vacuum cleaner.


- 1. Clean the surface of the vacuum cleaner and its accessories with a fresh and soft cloth.
- 2. Do not place any of the parts of the appliance in the dishwasher.





CLEANING THE HOSE


The hose is two components. In order to clean it, separate the two elements by pressing the button.



CARRIAGE AND STORAGE

1. You can lift and carry the vacuum cleaner using the carry handle. Never pull or lift the vacuum cleaner using the cord.

- 2. Before storing the vacuum cleaner, turn it off.
- 3. Unplug the vacuum cleaner from the socket.
- **4**. Rewind the cord by pressing the automatic cord rewind button.
- 5. For space-saving, the vacuum cleaner can be stored in an upright position.



TROUBLESHOOTING

WARNING

To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn off power and unplug from the mains before servicing.

Problem	Possible Issue	Solution
Loss of suction	Dust bag full	Change the dust bag. See "Changing the dust bag" section for more information.
Loss of suction	Dirty filters or blockage	1. Replace the dust bag and clean the filters. See "Cleaning the HEPA pre-motor filter" and "Cleaning the HEPA post-motor filter" sections for more information.
		2.Check for blockages in the floor tool, hose, metal telescopic tube and connectors.
		3. Remove any blockages before restarting the vacuum cleaner.
