

WARNING

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE

Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR INJURY:

USING THE VACUUM CLEANER

- DO NOT use the vacuum cleaner outdoors. For household use only. Store indoors.
- DO NOT vacuum up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws or coins that could damage the vacuum cleaner.
- DO NOT vacuum liquids, use on wet surfaces or immerse in water as this could cause damage to the vacuum cleaner.
- **DO NOT** vacuum anything flammable, burning or smoking such as cigarette ends, matchsticks or ashes.
- **DO NOT** use the vacuum cleaner to clean your pets or any animal.

- Keep the vacuum cleaner moving over the carpet surface at all times to avoid damaging the carpet fibres.
- Keep the vacuum cleaner and accessories away from hot surfaces like hobs, cookers or microwave ovens.
- Always unplug the vacuum cleaner immediately if it malfunctions.
- **DO NOT** use this vacuum cleaner if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, submerged in water or is not working as it should.
- **DO NOT** use the vacuum cleaner in an enclosed space filled with explosive, toxic or flammable vapours.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

PLUG AND CORD

- **DO NOT** use with a damaged cord or plug.
- •DO NOT pick up or pull the vacuum cleaner by the cord.
- •Take care that the cord is not kinked, pinched, pulled around sharp corners or run over.
- Ensure the cord does not come into contact with heat sources or become a trip hazard.
- •When unplugging the vacuum cleaner from the wall socket, pull by the plug, not the cord, holding the socket with your other hand.

AIRFLOW, FILTERS AND ATTACHMENTS

- **DO NOT** use without filters and bin in place.
- Always turn off and unplug the vacuum cleaner before changing filters or attachments.
- If when using, suction appears to be reduced, turn off and unplug the vacuum cleaner and clean all of the filters.
- •**DO NOT** use if the airflow is restricted. If the air paths or the floor nozzle become

- blocked, turn off and unplug the vacuum cleaner. Clear all obstructions before powering on again.
- Use genuine Dirt Devil filters and attachments only. Using non-genuine accessories may cause damage to the vacuum cleaner.
- When cleaning filters, ensure that they are completely dry and undamaged before replacing them back into the vacuum cleaner.

PERSONAL SAFETY

 This machine is not intended to be used or cleaned by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience or knowledge, unless they have been given instructions concerning the machine by a person legally responsible for their safety. They should be supervised whilst using the machine. Children shall not use, clean or play with this machine, which when not in use should be secured out of their reach. Keep the vacuum cleaner out of reach of children.

- Packing material must not be used for playing. There is a danger of suffocation.
- Never leave the vacuum cleaner connected to the mains without supervision.
- Keep the floor nozzle away from hair, face, fingers, uncovered feet or loose clothing when the vacuum cleaner is working or plugged in
- DO NOT use with wet hands.






ASSEMBLING YOUR VACUUM CLEANER

ASSEMBLING YOUR VACUUM CLEANER


Always unplug your appliance from the wall socket before assembling or removing accessories.



1. Attach the hose into the hose connection.




2. Fit the telescopic tube to the curved hose extension.



3. Push the other end of the telescopic tube into the floor tool. Adjust the telescopic tube to the desired length.


CARRYING AND MOVING THE APPLIANCE

There is a handle on the top of the vacuum cleaner which you can use to conveniently carry it.






1. Once all attachments are in place, unwind a sufficient length of cable. A yellow mark on the cord shows the ideal cable length. Do not pull the cord beyond the red mark.



2. Insert the power plug into the wall outlet.



3. Press the power button located on the main body of the appliance to turn the vacuum cleaner on.



4. To rewind the power cord once you have finished cleaning, press the cord rewind button with one hand and guide the power cord with the other hand to ensure that it does not whip causing damage or injury.




CLEANING THE DUST BIN

WARNING

Always unplug the appliance from the wall socket before removing the dust bin or cleaning the filters.

- 1. Press the knob on the dust bin handle.
- 2. Lift the dust bin up and out as shown in figure 1.
- 3. Press the knob on the lower end of the dust bin to open the bottom cover as shown in figure 2. Empty the dirt.
- 4. Twist the dust cup and dust bin cover to open it as shown in figure 3.
- 5. Clean the plastic parts of the dust bin with a damp soft cloth if necessary. Wait until fully dry to reassemble the vacuum cleaner.








REMOVING THE HEPA PRE-MOTOR FILTER


- 1. Remove the dust bin from the vacuum cleaner.
- 2. Press the knob on the dust bin handle.
- 3. Lift up the dust bin up and out.
- 4. Lift up the dust bin upper cover button.
- 5. Open the dust bin upper cover.
- 6. Remove the filter located behind the bin to clean or change it. The HEPA pre-motor filter comes in two parts. Follow the cleaning instructions on page 9 to clean the filters.





NOTE: Pay attention to where each part of the filter is situated in the dust bin so you can replace both parts correctly.

REMOVING THE HEPA POST-MOTOR FILTER









2. Remove the HEPA post-motor filter to clean or change it. Follow the cleaning instructions below to clean the filter.

CLEANING THE HEPA PRE-MOTOR AND POST-MOTOR FILTERS

The filters in the vacuum cleaner will become dusty over time. This is normal and will not affect their performance. However, if the filters become so dusty that suction power is reduced:

- 1. Remove the filters.
- 2. Rinse the filters under the tap.
- **3.** Allow the filters to air dry for 24 hours. (Do not use a heater, fire, hairdryer or other high-temperature appliance to dry the filters.)
- 4. Refit the filters into the vacuum.

This should be done once every six months or when suction appears to be reduced.

IMPORTANT

All filters should be checked regularly for signs of damage, preferably after each cleaning task. The filters must be replaced immediately if they become damaged.

REMOVING OBSTRUCTIONS

The suction hole must be open and free of any obstructions at all times. Otherwise, the motor will overheat and could become damaged.

IMPORTANT

Please note that there is a safety valve inside the vacuum to prevent the unit from being run with a high vacuum rate. If the vacuum rate is too high, the safety valve will be turned on to protect the motor from being broken.

TROUBLESHOOTING

WARNING: To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn off and unplug before servicing.

Problem	Possible Issue	Solution
Loss of suction	Dust bin full	Empty the dust bin. See "Cleaning the dust bin" section for more information.
Loss of suction	Dirty filters or blockage	1. Empty the dust bin and clean the filters. See "Removing the HEPA pre-motor filter", "Removing the centric HEPA filter", "Removing the HEPA post-motor filter" and "Cleaning the filter" sections for more information.
		2.Check for blockages in the floor tool, hose, metal telescopic tube and connectors.
		3. Remove any blockages before restarting the vacuum cleaner.
