

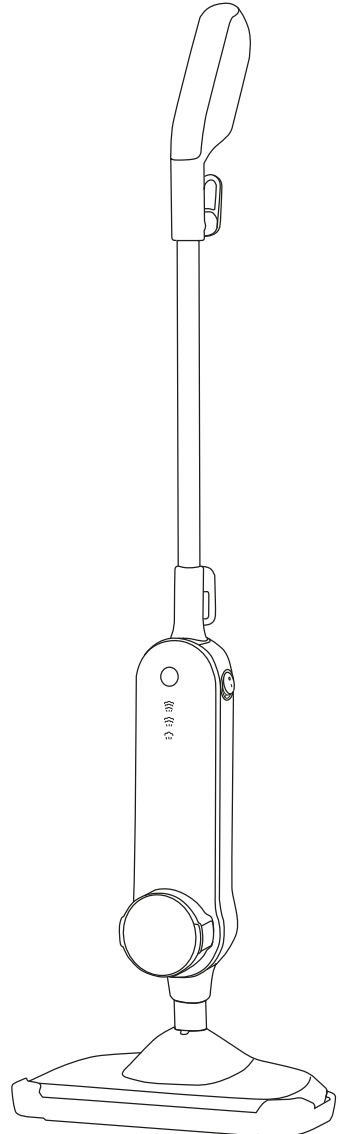

### **WARNING**

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed.

### **READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE**

Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.

## **USING THE STEAM CLEANER**

- **DO NOT** use the steam mop outdoors. For household use only. Store indoors.
- **DO NOT** leave steam mop unattended.
- **DO NOT** immerse in liquid.
- **DO NOT** use this steam mop if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, submerged in water or is not working as it should..
- **DO NOT** use the steam mop in an enclosed space filled with explosive, toxic or flammable vapours.
- Always vacuum your carpets thoroughly and ensure hard floor areas are free from grit and debris before using your steam mop.
- The steam mop should not be used to clean electrical appliances, sockets, components or wires.
- Liquid or steam should not be directed towards electrical equipment.
- **DO NOT** attempt to remove blockages with sharp objects as this may cause damage to the steam mop.
- Filling the tank with hot or boiling water will damage the steam mop and invalidate the warranty.
- Unplug the steam mop immediately if it malfunctions.
- Before storing the steam mop, make sure the tank is empty and clean.
- **DO NOT** leave the steam mop turned on or connected to the mains when unattended.

# IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

## FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

---

### SUITABILITY

- **DO NOT** use on wax polished floors or furniture, acrylic surfaces and synthetic, velvet or steam/water-sensitive materials.
- Before using on a floor or surface, refer to the surface manufacturer's care recommendations. If the surface is suitable for steam cleaning, test for damage on a small hidden area. If no distortion, discolouration or damage occurs, continue cleaning.
- **DO NOT** put descaling, aromatic, alcoholic or detergent products into the steam mop, as this may damage it or make it unsafe for use. Always fill the tank with cold water only.

### PLUG AND CORD

- Switch off and unplug the steam cleaner at the socket when not in use and before conducting maintenance or troubleshooting.
- **DO NOT** use with a damaged cord or plug.
- **DO NOT** pick up or pull the steam mop by the cord. Always carry the steam mop by the handle.

- Take care that the cord is not kinked, pinched, pulled around sharp corners or run over.
- Ensure the cord does not come into contact with heat sources or become a trip hazard.
- When unplugging the steam mop from the wall socket, pull by the plug, not the cord, holding the socket with your other hand.
- **DO NOT** use if the power cord is damaged.
- Turn off all controls on the steam mop before disconnecting or connecting the power cord. After use, always wrap the power cord around the cord latches provided.

### USING ATTACHMENTS

- Always turn off and unplug the steam mop before changing attachments.
- Always make sure the tank and attachments are fitted correctly before using the steam mop.
- Use genuine Dirt Devil attachments only. Using non-genuine attachments may cause damage to the steam mop.

# IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

### PERSONAL SAFETY

- **DO NOT** expose hair, loose clothing, fingers or body parts to openings or moving parts.
- **DO NOT** aim the steam mop at people and animals.
- Never touch the steam jet or mop head from a short distance as there is a risk of scalding.
- **DO NOT** touch any hot areas or attachments on your steam mop. It's normal for the steam mop and attachments to heat up during use. Always allow them to cool down before handling.
- **DO NOT** handle steam mop with wet hands.
- This machine is not intended to be used or cleaned by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience or knowledge, unless they have been given instructions concerning the machine by a person legally responsible for their safety. They should be supervised whilst using the machine. Children shall not use, clean or play with this machine, which when not in use should be secured out of their reach. Keep the vacuum cleaner out of

reach of children. Packing material must not be used for playing. There is a danger of suffocation.

- **DO NOT** use the steam mop to clean or refresh any items of clothing that are still being worn on the body.
- Take extra care when cleaning on the stairs.

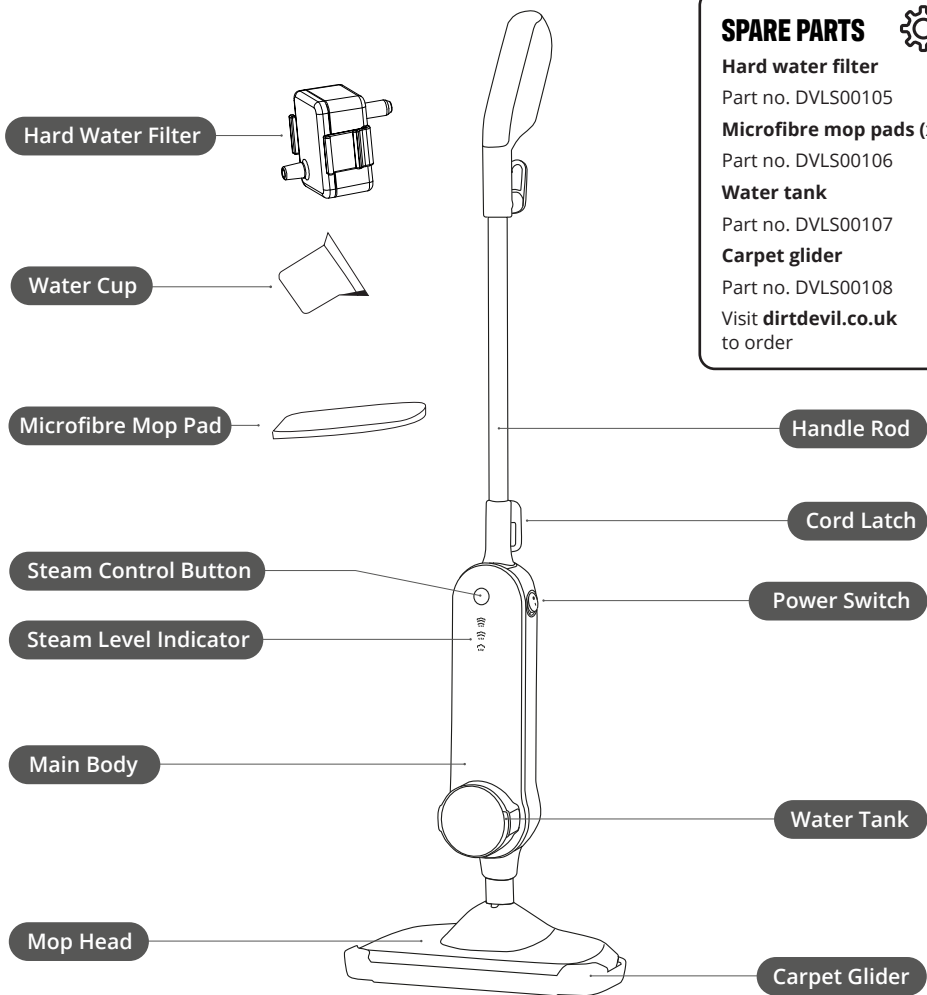

## ASSEMBLING YOUR STEAM MOP

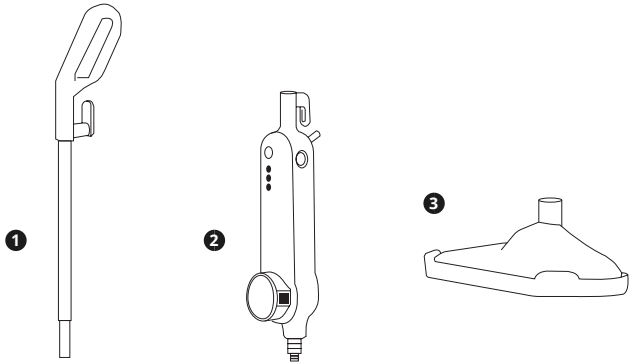
### CAUTION

The steam cleaner and accessories get very hot during use. Always allow them to cool down before handling.

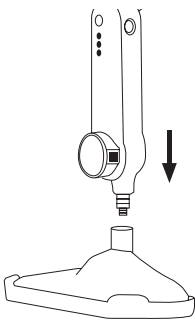
Before assembling or disassembling attachments and accessories, emptying the tank or changing the microfibre mop pad, ensure the steam cleaner is not plugged into the mains supply and is switched off.

Your steam mop assembles quickly and easily. It is packaged with the following items:

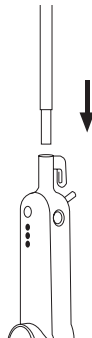
1. Handle
2. Main Body
3. Mop Head



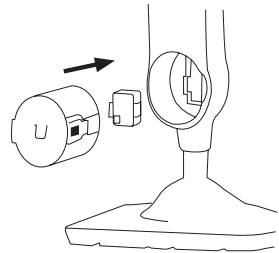
## TO ASSEMBLE YOUR STEAM MOP:



**1.** Attach the main body to the mop head by snapping it into place.



**2.** Insert the handle into the main body until it locks into the right place.



**3.** Install the water tank into the main body.

Steam mop assembly is now complete. Thoroughly sweep or vacuum the floor before cleaning with the steam mop.

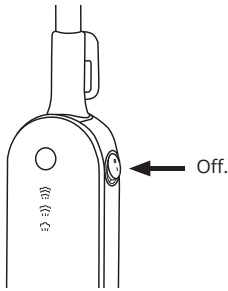

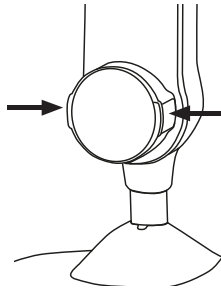

## FILLING THE WATER TANK

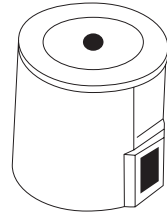
The removable water tank is located at the bottom of the main body. Filtered water is recommended in place of tap water. To fill your steam mop:



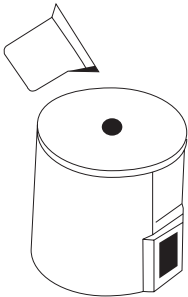
**1.** Ensure the steam mop is turned off.



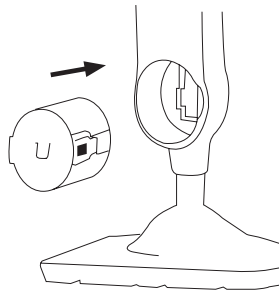
**2.** Press the buttons on both sides of the water tank and pull it out.



**3.** Pull out the rubber plug on the back of the tank.



**4.** Fill the water tank with the water cup. For best results, water should be at room temperature.



**5.** Replace the water tank and gently slide it into place.

When the steam mop stops emitting steam, unplug the unit. Simply remove the water tank, refill and continue steaming.

**NOTE:** Upon first use of the steam mop or first use after refilling the water tank, the pump may make a “knocking” sound. This is normal and should only last a few seconds.

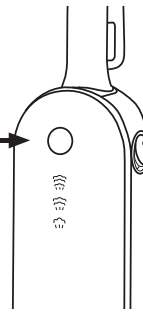

## USING THE STEAM CONTROL



Power Switch

1. Press the power switch.



Steam Control

2. Press the steam control button to choose the level of steam you desire. Please note that when you first press the steam control button, the steam is at its maximum level.

3. The steam level indicator light will stop blinking when the steam mop is ready to use.

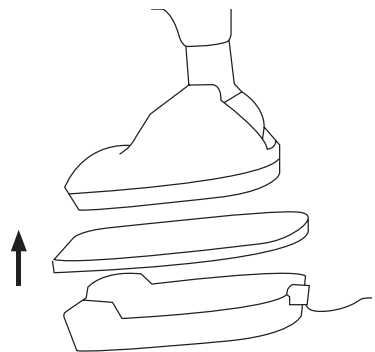
## ATTACHING THE MICROFIBRE MOP PAD

The reusable microfibre mop pads are machine washable and safe for virtually all hard floor surfaces.

The microfibre mop pad may already be attached to the mop head when you unbox your steam mop. If not:

1. Place the microfibre mop pad on the floor, velcro side up. Place the steam mop onto the pad and attach the pad to the velcro at the bottom of the mop head. Make sure the pad covers the entire base of the mop head.
2. If you are refreshing carpets, once you have attached the microfibre mop pad, hook the steam mop into the front of the carpet glider and push to clip in place.

**NOTE:** To ensure the floor is disinfected, use the microfibre mop pad and wipe the steam mop back and forth at least three times with continuous steam. For best results, remove the microfibre mop pad and clean it after each use.

## CLEANING HARD FLOORS

Your steam mop is designed to clean hard floors such as ceramic, tile, vinyl, laminate, marble, stone and sealed hardwood floors. Use of your steam mop on waxed or some unwaxed floors may result in diminished glossiness. Test the steam mop in an inconspicuous area and check the care instructions from your flooring manufacturer before use.

1. Plug the unit in and wait 30 seconds for it to heat up.
2. Choose the level of steam to clean your floor. The lowest steam level is ideal for delicate floors, the medium level is best suited to regular cleaning and the highest steam level allows you to clean durable floors or sticky messes.
3. Begin cleaning by slowly passing the unit over the floor surface.

## CLEANING CARPETS

The carpet glider accessory attaches to the steam mop to allow it to slide over the carpet and clean it.

Please make sure that the carpet glider has been securely buckled onto the floor head. If it is not in the correct position, the carpet glider will fall off during cleaning.

**NOTE:** Move the steam mop in a continuous motion until you are finished. **DO NOT** leave the mop in a stationary position

## TURNING OFF YOUR STEAM MOP

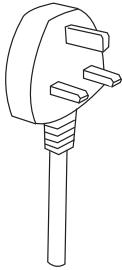
To turn off the steam mop, continue to press the steam control button until the blue light above it is illuminated.

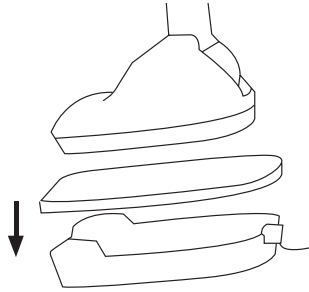

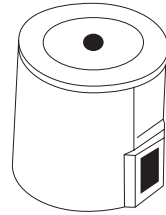
## STORING YOUR STEAM MOP



**1.** Unplug the power cord from the socket.



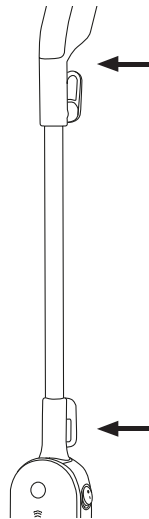
**2.** Carefully remove the microfibre mop pad from the mop head. The microfibre mop pad and lower assembly may be hot.



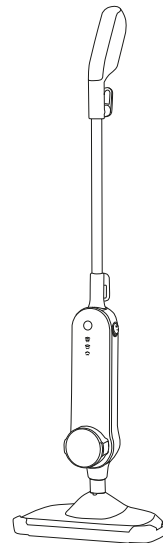
**3.** Any water remaining in the water tank should be emptied before storing.



**4.** The microfibre mop pad can be machine washed in warm water. Use only liquid detergents. Do not use fabric softeners or bleach. For best results, air dry.



**5.** Wrap the power cord around the latches on the back of the steam mop.



**6.** Wipe all surfaces of the steam mop with a soft cloth. Store upright in a protected, dry area.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

---

**WARNING:** To reduce the risk of electric shock, burns or unintended operation, turn off the power, unplug from the mains and allow the appliance to fully cool down before servicing.

Problem	Possible issue	Solution
Reduced steam or no steam	Water tank empty	Fill tank
Reduced steam or no steam	Steam level not selected	Select steam level by pushing the steam control button
